It is requested that the child takes proper rest at home and comes back to school happy & healthy, with full vigour to give her/his best in the school. The student can rejoin school as per the advice from doctor and issuance of Medical Fitness Certificate.

As a preventive measure, students are permitted to wear blue full sleeve shirts, navy blue trousers, skin coloured stockings for the time being.
