Subject: Advisory on Conjunctivitis (Eye Flu) Prevention

Dear Parent,

Delhi is witnessing a sudden outbreak of conjunctivitis (Eye Flu) due to heavy rains and water logging in the National Capital in the last few days. Cases of Conjunctivitis or Pink Eye have been reported in high numbers.

Viral and bacterial conjunctivitis are very contagious. They can spread easily from person to person. Preventing the Eye Flu is necessary for avoiding the inconveniences caused by the infection. You can greatly reduce the risk of getting Conjunctivitis or spreading it by following simple steps for good hygiene.

- One must maintain good hygiene which includes washing hands regularly and avoiding touching eyes with bare or unwashed hands.
- One must also avoid sharing personal belongings such as towels, lenses or glasses.
- Keep your surroundings clean and hygienic.

You are advised to be aware about the highly infectious nature of Conjunctivitis. One infected person can spread the disease to many others who come in his or her contact. If your ward or any member in the family is suffering from Conjunctivitis then you must not send your ward to school, even if your ward has any test/assessment. If your ward comes to school with Conjunctivitis infection then he or she puts everyone under threat who comes in contact with him or her.

Since Conjunctivitis is highly infectious, you are hereby advised to take all needful precautions for a quick and healthy recovery.
