**Subject: Advisory**

Dear Parents & Students,

“Children are the world’s most valuable resource and the best hope for the future.”

A healthy, secure and positive environment is needed for their wholesome growth. Therefore, students are requested to adhere to the following guidelines.

### **Disciplinary Advisory**

- **NO STUDENT SHOULD COME TO SCHOOL ON A SELF-DRIVEN VEHICLE.**
- **Students must reach school by 8.30 a.m. positively. School gates will be closed sharp at 8.30 a.m.**
- Students should report to school in proper uniform and proper haircut. Any kind of fashionable or coloured hairstyle is not allowed in the school.
- Girls must not use any make up/coloured hair/long nails/henna on hands or any other fashionable get up.
- Students must not wear jewellery or carry any expensive gadgets, smart watch and mobile phones to school.
- Students must bring light bags to school, as per the time table provided. Also ensure that your ward carries lunch box and water bottle in their bag itself.
- No parent shall be permitted to give lunch box & water bottles to their ward during school time.

### **Transport Advisory**

- Parents must have driver’s details with regard to Driving License, RC Number ID, Proof and Police verification report with regard to the character and antecedents of the driver for the safety and security of their wards.
- Parents must be very alert and cautious with respect to the transportation arrangements done by them for to and fro of their ward.

### **Health Advisory**

- You must follow all do’s and don’ts for Dengue, Chikungunya and Malaria as per School Circular No. St.CPS/2023/24/SP/18 dated 24.07.2023
- You must follow all do’s and don’ts for prevention of Conjunctivitis (Eye Flu) as per Circular no. St.CPS/2023/24/SP/19 dated 01.08.2023.
- Students must wear full sleeves clothing to avoid mosquito bites and use mosquito repellents ointment.
- If your ward is suffering from cold, cough, fever or any other infectious disease like Conjunctivitis then you must not send your ward to school to ensure complete rest and quick recovery of your ward.

### **Cyber Safety & Security Advisory**

- Parents must monitor the use of internet by their wards and keep a strict watch on the internet activities such as social networking, chatting, online games,etc. to keep themselves away from any cyber harm/fraud/crime.
- You are requested to protect your child from cyber bullying and abuse by monitoring their internet usage.
