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## **ANNUAL REPORT 2025-26**

Under the visionary leadership of our esteemed management — Chairman Sir, Madam Manager, and Director Sir — the institution continues to advance with clarity of purpose and social responsibility. Their far-sightedness, coupled with the dedication of a highly competent faculty, enables the school to consistently deliver outstanding outcomes. Supported by modern infrastructure and a progressive outlook, the school provides an ideal setting for comprehensive development.

We have deep appreciation for the strategic leadership of the Academic Advisors and our Coordinators whose guidance has been instrumental in ensuring seamless and successful functioning of the institution. The commitment to nurturing every learner is reflected in the tireless efforts of our teaching fraternity, who work with sincerity and passion to guide students towards self-discovery and achievement. Their role extends beyond instruction, shaping individuals who are confident, responsible, compassionate, and capable.

The non-teaching support staff of the school form the backbone of the institution's smooth and efficient functioning. With exceptional organizational skills and a profound sense of responsibility, the administrative team ensures that all official processes are executed with precision. Equally praise-worthy are the efforts of the support staff whose steadfast contributions uphold the school environment with care, discipline and order.

We express our deep appreciation to our students, whose perseverance and determination continue to enthrall us. Their willingness to adapt, learn, and excel forms the true foundation of our success.

This year also, the perseverance is reflected in CBSE results which are commendable. In the Commerce stream, Prerit Kataria emerged as the top scorer with an outstanding 98%, followed by Bhavya Malhotra with 96.8% and Parth Maggo with 95.8%. In the Science stream, Ansh Soni secured the highest position with 94%, while Piyush Aggarwal and Shubham Aggarwal followed closely with 93.8% and 92.8% respectively. The students collectively achieved 580 distinctions and 214 merits, reflecting consistent academic excellence. Perfect scores of 100/100 were attained in Business Studies, Psychology, and Painting, highlighting subject proficiency at the highest level.

In Class X as well, students delivered an impressive performance. Unnat Bhatia secured the top position with 96.4%, followed by Kashvi Prasad Gupta with 96% and Bhavya Suri with 95.2%. The cohort achieved a total of 482 distinctions and 179 merits, with four students attaining a perfect score in Information Technology. These accomplishments stand as a source of inspiration for the entire student community.

The achievements of our students were celebrated with great pride during the Annual Function, where meritorious performers were honoured with awards and recognitions. Scholarship of Rs. 24,000 each was awarded to the students of Class XII who scored aggregate 85 % - 94.9 % marks in Class XI. Similarly, students of Class XI who had scored an aggregate of 90 % - 96.9 % in Class X were given the scholarship of Rs. 24,000 each. Along with this, Exclusive Scholarship Award of Rs. 6,000 each was given to three students of Class XII for their exemplary score in Political Science subject in Class XI. This scholarship is given in the fond memory of Sardar Mohinder Singh whose son, Prof Bir Inder Singh, Retired Professor of Political Science of SGTB Khalsa College, University of Delhi, had graced the Annual Function and acclaimed the students.

Our alumni continue to bring distinction to the institution through their notable accomplishments. Piyush Aggarwal and Ansh Soni successfully cleared the IIT-JEE Advanced Examination 2025, securing CRL ranks of 5003 and 23286 respectively. Shubham Vachher gained admission to the Himalayan Institute of

Medical Science, while Nishtha Kanwar secured a place at Kalka Dental College, Meerut, further exemplifying the strong academic foundation laid at the school.

Among student achievements, Aayaan Ali of Class XII earned the third position in the Vanijya Shree – International Commerce Olympiad organised by the Commerce Teachers Foundation, marking a significant accomplishment at the international level.

Adding to the institution's pride, Ms. Prajjya Dutta, PGT Computer Science and Senior Coordinator, was honoured with the Best Teacher's Award by the Atal Sahodaya Group during the Guru Vandan Samaroh for her exceptional contribution to education.

With dedication and sincerity, our students have excelled in prestigious competitions such as the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge. Sidhant Sharma, Harshika Raheja and Sehejdeep Singh - Class X students were ranked among the top 100 in the West Zone.

We take immense pride in offering structured training in sports and performing arts, including disciplines such as shooting, archery, cricket, table tennis, and orchestra. With the guidance of skilled coaches, students are encouraged to refine their abilities and pursue excellence in their chosen fields, which integrates talent refinement into the academic framework.

The Annual Day celebration was graced by the presence of the Distinguished Management of the school along with the Chief Guest - Dr Susheela Negi - Scientist F and our Guest of Honour - Ms Kavita Dwibedi - an expert Odissi dancer. The cultural spectacle - "Legends of Asia," was a magnificent confluence of heritage, and artistic expression, where the timeless tales of Asia came alive on stage through captivating dramatisations. Showcasing the rich traditions, legendary figures, and diverse cultural ethos of the continent, the presentation beautifully conveyed profound messages of peace, harmony, courage, and wisdom. The event was thoughtfully interwoven with graceful dance performances, compelling theatrical enactments, and elocutions by students. It left the audience inspired and immersed in the enduring legacy of Asian traditions.

The school organised Orientation Programmes for classes Nursery, I, VI and IX, designed to acquaint parents with the academic framework, institutional guidelines, and pedagogical approaches to be adopted throughout the session. These sessions served as a vital platform to align expectations and equip both parents and students with clarity and confidence for the year ahead. The school counsellor also addressed the gathering, offering valuable insights into essential life skills and their enduring relevance in a child's holistic development.

The school also successfully hosted Odyssey 2025, an inter-school competition that witnessed participation from nearly 400 students across Delhi-NCR. The event provided a stimulating platform for students to showcase their skills while promoting healthy competition and collaborative learning.

In its continued endeavour to cultivate leadership, discipline, and a spirit of collaboration, the school conducted the Investiture Ceremony. A meticulous selection process, comprising rigorous interviews by a panel of educators, led to the appointment of deserving candidates to the Student Council. The solemn occasion of badge conferment marked the formal induction of young leaders, as proud parents witnessed their children assume positions of responsibility with dignity and promise.

St. Cecilia's also hosted its third edition of Model United Nations in the school premises. The delegates exhibited remarkable acumen through their articulate deliberations, insightful discourses, and well-structured position papers, addressing critical global concerns. Their engagements reflected a deep understanding of contemporary international issues and a commitment to proposing viable, forward-thinking solutions.

The MUN Closing Ceremony was graced by eminent dignitaries who lauded the participants for their intellectual understanding and analytical depth. The ceremony culminated in the conferment of awards upon the most outstanding delegates, honouring their exemplary performance and distinguished merit.

The Badge Ceremony was held to confer badges upon the most deserving students. Currently, eight clubs are functioning in the school, i.e., Democracy Club, Commerce Club, Eco Club, Editorial Club, Geekoz IT Club, Mathematics Club, Scientia Club, and Quiz Club.

Democracy Club engaged students in events such as Youth Parliament, Mock Elections and Tiranga Rally Campaign.

The Commerce Club organised visits to Yakult and Mother Dairy plants for class XII commerce stream students. The visits offered practical exposure to food processing operations, supply chain management and quality control processes in the dairy industry and packaging procedures and marketing strategies of a globally recognized FMCG brand.

The Eco Club captained campaigns and Diwali Assembly and celebrations to encourage students to commit to a greener planet. It organized a Plantation Drive to spread the message of sustaining greenery in the environment. Students and teachers planted saplings in the school.

The Editorial Club organized engaging competitions such as poetry recitations, extempores, newspaper activities, expression series etc to foster literary skills and enhance students' linguistic proficiency.

The Geekoz IT Club hosted competitions like Python Programming, MS Paint, Movie Making Competitions, etc.

The Scientia Club aims to enrich students' scientific temperament and rational abilities. Experiential learning remained their key focus throughout the year. The **Science Exhibition** on Innovation in Science & Technology towards Sustainable Development encouraged inquiry-based learning and scientific thinking was a huge success as students enjoyed learning by doing.

The Quiz Club has been steadfast in cultivating intellectual acuity among students, enriching their proficiency across diverse domains such as general awareness, literature, history, technology, and science.

The Mathematics Club assumed a significant role in refining students' numerical proficiency and analytical reasoning by organising a range of engaging competitions and activities, including Mathematical Rap, Declamation, Shopping Bill activity among others.

Students exercise discerning choice in selecting their areas of interest and engage with remarkable enthusiasm. Such pursuits not only sharpen their competencies but also provide a collaborative platform that fosters camaraderie and a healthy competitive spirit.

The Installation Ceremony marked the formal constitution of the student leadership body, comprising individuals who exemplify the ideals of 'social welfare' inspiring their peers to emulate these values. The solemn occasion witnessed students taking a pledge to uphold the principles of peace, universal brotherhood, kindness, compassion, and empathy in both thought and action.

In the spirit of altruism and social responsibility, the Interact Club organised the 'Winter Carnival' in December, celebrating the ethos of the 'Joy of Giving'. The event served as a meaningful initiative to raise funds for the welfare of the underprivileged. It featured an array of vibrant stalls curated by students of Classes VIII, IX, X, and XI, offering an engaging mix of interactive games alongside a delightful assortment of culinary treats including bakery items, chaat, idli and dosa and various other items.

A generous amount was collected for donation. As part of the donation drive, students visited several charitable institutions, including Rashtriya Virjanand Andh Kanya Vidyalaya (Vikaspuri), Seva Bharti Matrichhaya (Paschim Vihar), Don Bosco Ashalayam (Palam Village, Dwarka), and an Old Age Home in the neighbourhood. Essential provisions such as ration supplies, toiletries, baby and adult diapers, along with other daily-use items, were distributed to the beneficiaries to address their immediate needs.

In addition to material assistance, students engaged the elderly in thoughtful conversations, listening with empathy to their life experiences and concerns.

The middle wing presented '**Beyond the Lens**', highlighting practical applications of CBSE Skill Modules. Different skill modules were learnt by the students like Artificial Intelligence and Information Technology, Financial Literacy, Health and Wellness, Handicrafts and Designs, Travel and Tourism, Embroidery etc. to acquire first hand experience to enhance their skills and aptitude.

Students of Grades IV and V showcased '**Facets of India: Struggle to Strength**', showcasing a display of well-prepared models, charts and projects highlighting India's richness and triumph. Students presented India's ascent through exhibits highlighting freedom struggles, patriotism in the modern era, the nation's armed forces, cultural and natural heritage, and eras of excellence showcasing its pioneers.

Class III students presented "**Save Earth, Save Life**", spreading awareness about environmental responsibility through meaningful expression.

Students enrolled in the Cambridge English Assessment Programme received notable recognition, including an invitation to **visit the British Council Library** in New Delhi. The school was also honoured with two awards at the Annual Coordinators' Conference organised by Cambridge English, reaffirming its commitment to global educational standards. We were recognised as the Cambridge English Examination Preparation Centre along with a trophy 'Emerging Star of the Year'.

Visits to National Gallery of Modern Art, Institute of Human Behaviour and Allied Sciences and Dr. Ambedkar International Centre propelled students towards joyful learning beyond the classroom.

The academic year was enriched with a wide range of workshops and awareness sessions on topics such as Assertive and Aggressive Communication, Career Counselling, Body Shaming Vs Body Positivity, etc; aimed at developing critical

thinking and life skills. Social initiatives undertaken during the year continued to instil values of empathy, responsibility, and community service among students.

We, at St. Cecilia's whole-heartedly believe that learning is a lifelong process and learning at every step of life proves beneficial in our growth as well as others' progress. Keeping this in mind, three CBSE Capacity Building Programmes were organised for the teachers on topics - Art Integration, Happy Classroom and Mental Health and Wellness of the Learners. Teachers gained priceless insights with respect to novel teaching methodologies to create a joyous learning environment in the classrooms.

Participation in inter-school and zonal competitions was commendable. Students secured accolades across academic, cultural, and sporting domains.

A remarkable benchmark is set by our athletes wherein our Under-17 Archery team - Jiya Arya, Samaira and Alaina Tamang - brought a gold medal in the CBSE National Archery Competition along with two Silver Medals in Under-14 individual -Jaskirat Kaur - and under 14 team - Jaskirat Kaur and Samaira.

A prestigious gold medal was won by the under 15 girls team - Jaskirat Kaur, Samaira and Alaina Tamang - in an Archery Federation event!

In the under 13 - Mishti Tyagi - and under 10 - Gyanvi Tyagi - individual Archery events, we brought home silver medals each.

Three bronze medals came to us in the under 15 individual girls round, Archery, shooting girls team and Taekwondo Tournament team each.

A wonderful second position was secured by Gunveer Singh Khurana in the Delhi State Shooting Pistol Event and our rope skipping girls team brought the first prize with their diligence & talent.

Four first prizes and four third prizes adorn the school walls in different events in Delhi Yogasana Sports.

In the Zonal Swimming competition, Mayank won the first position in Freestyle (50 mtr) and also the first position in Breast stroke in 50 mtr and 100 mtr both.

In the 19th Ramjas Inter-school Table Tennis competition held at Ramjas School, Anandparvat, Arnav Suneja got the fabulous Best Player Trophy Award.

In the Inter school Table Tennis competition, Rudransh Thakuri won the Best Player of the Tournament Award in Individual under 9 boys.

Arnav Suneja got the Best Player of the Tournament Award in individual under 15 boys.

It's an absolute honour to mention that Cecilians bagged so many prizes in Texplora 2.0 - An Inter school Tech Fest at Mount Carmel, Dwarka, 23rd Sh Brem Dutt Verma Memorial Inter school competition held at Cambridge Foundation School, Cynosure, held at G.D. Goenka Public School, Paschim Vihar, Technophilia held at Mamta Modern School, Fantasia held at Adarsh Public School, and so on.

But the list of accomplishments doesn't stop here. Dhruv Awasthi secured the first position in the Senior boys Hindi Declamation at zonal level. He also secured the first position at district level and reached the State level.

Tavleen Kaur won the wonderful first position in Punjabi Poem Recitation Junior girls.

Agambir Singh and Samrat Sachdeva brought another first prize to the school in the English Debate competition in the Junior boys.

More prestigious prizes were secured in Poster making competition, Instrumental music, Folk Dance and Folk Song, English Poetry Recitation, Science Slogan writing, Extempore and so forth.
