This is to inform you that, in accordance with the New Three-Language Policy, students entering Class IX are required to study one Indian language (Sanskrit or Punjabi) in addition to English and Hindi.

Students currently studying in Classes VII and VIII who have opted for French as their third language will need to learn the basics of either Sanskrit or Punjabi so that they do not face difficulty when they reach Class IX. To facilitate this, the school is arranging introductory classes for both subjects.

You are requested to choose one of the following subjects and indicate your preference in the space provided below. The language selected will continue as the third language until Class X. Students studying French in Classes VII and VIII will continue to be evaluated only in French during this session. They will not be evaluated in Sanskrit or Punjabi selected below during current session as one time measure.
