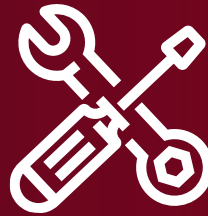

CODE OF CONDUCT

As a participant in the CECILIAN SABHA SUMMIT, it is essential to adhere to the following code of conduct to ensure a respectful and productive environment for all:

- Participation is limited to students from classes 7 to 12 only, NO PASSOUTS are allowed.
- Members must use respectful and diplomatic language at all times while maintaining the decorum and upholding the principle of diplomacy throughout the session.
- Any form of personal attacks, offensive remarks, inappropriate language or disruptive behaviour is strictly prohibited.
- Decisions made by the Executive Board (EB) are final and binding, and will not be subject to change.
- All participants are required to adhere to the designated dress code.
- Use of music or any form of audio is not permitted during formal debate sessions.
- Participants are requested to use allotted dustbins for disposal and avoid wastage of edible resources.
- Students are encouraged to carry their own water bottles, however, clean drinking water will be available at the school premises.
- Use of phones for selfies, playing music, or non-academic purposes is strictly forbidden. Defaulters will be disqualified without refund.
- Phones or research material devices may only be used within designated committees. Usage outside these areas will lead to strict action from the Executive Board.
- Direct plagiarism from artificial intelligence tools is strictly prohibited and may result in disqualification.
- Physical altercations or any form of aggression during formal debates are strictly prohibited.
