Dear Parents,

The School values the cooperation and support of parents in maintaining a positive, respectful and conducive educational environment. Any concern or grievance pertaining to the school or its staff may kindly be brought to the notice of the appropriate authority in a polite, courteous and constructive manner. Parents are requested to maintain mutual respect and trust in all interactions with teachers and school personnel, recognizing that the common objective is the well-being and holistic development of every child.

Parents are requested to take note of the following:

- Parents are encouraged to spend quality time with their children, discuss their experiences at school and remain aware of their academic and emotional well-being.
- In case a parent observes any drastic change in the child's actions, behaviour, health or thoughts, the same should be communicated to the school teacher/counsellor/coordinator promptly so that appropriate support may be extended.
- If a child is medically unwell, parents are requested to exercise discretion and ensure that the child resumes school only when fit to attend. The child must bring a medical /fitness certificate in this case. You are requested to follow adequate precautions for prevention against the Vector Borne diseases as mentioned in the school circular - Ref. No. St. CPS/2026/27/SP/19 dated 25.07.2026.
- Regularity and punctuality of students must be ensured at all times. School gates close at 8:30 a.m. sharp.
- Students must attend school in the prescribed school uniform, neat and complete in all respects.
- Students must strictly refrain from any form of make-up, coloured hair, jewellery or other unauthorised accessories. In classes XI and XII, girls must come in one/two plait. Likewise, in classes I to X, two plaits are compulsory. Ribbons must be tied neatly till class V.
