

The father of the Nation, Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi stands as a symbol of peace and non-violence. He was born on 2nd October, 1869 at Porbandar in Gujrat. He is lovingly called Bapu. He had a great contribution in the struggle for freedom.

Every year Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated on 2nd October to mark the birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. The school also organised activities for the students to celebrate this day. Students took keen interest in participating in the celebration with full enthusiasm. A short assembly was conducted in which Principal ma'ams message for students was played. Gandhiji's favourite bhajans were sung.

Children participated in activities like Express yourself (Speaking few lines on the Mahatma as well as on Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri), poetry recitation, singing bhajans, narration of anecdotes from the life of Gandhiji and dances on patriotic songs. They sang the beautiful bhajan 'Raghupati Raghav Raja Ram' taught to them by their music teachers. Children enthusiastically displayed their drawings and paintings on Mahatma Gandhi.

Students of classes IV and V also showed their beautiful PowerPoint presentations on Gandhiji and Sh. Lal Bahadur Shastri. Some of them played bhajans on Casio and showed role play on Swachh Bharat.

The lessons that we learn from the life of Gandhiji and anecdotes/ short stories from his life were discussed and narrated by the teachers. Madam Meena took a session on Gandhiji and Sh. Lal Bahadur Shastri in all primary classes (III - V) and posted the same in their WhatsApp groups.
