As part of the Quiz club, various map activities were organised in TERM 1 for students of grade 10th which included activities to know more about the country INDIA.

These activities were an effective way to teach students about both the political and physical geography of India.

Activity 1: Major Soil Types of India was conducted in the month of May where students gained a comprehensive understanding of India's soil types and their regional distribution. The activity improved their ability to connect soil characteristics with specific agricultural practices and environmental factors.

In the month of July, activity 2: Major Dams of India was conducted. This activity aimed to help students learn about the major dams in India, their locations, and their importance in water resource management, irrigation, and power generation.

The students became more knowledgeable about the geographic distribution of dams in India

Later in the month of August, activity 3: - Major Areas of Rice and Wheat and Major producer states of Sugarcane, Tea, Coffee, Rubber, Cotton and Jute was conducted.

The objective of this activity was to teach students about the regions of India that are most suitable for the cultivation of rice and wheat, sugarcane etc. that plays a significant role in the country's agricultural economy.
