As part of the Quiz club, various map activities were organised in TERM 2 for students of grade 9th and 10th which included activities to know more about the country INDIA.

Students of class 9th located <u>Major rivers of India</u> showing the drainage pattern, understanding the course of major rivers and their tributaries. A <u>climate map</u> activity providing a visual representation of different climatic zones across a region, allowed students to locate and label the distribution of temperature, rainfall patterns, which helped them to understand how climate varies geographically and its impacts on human activities.

Class 10th students' map activities were designed to enhance their understanding of how the resources are distributed across different regions. Students located and labelled <u>Major manufacturing industries</u>(Cotton textile, Iron and steel plants and Software Technology park), Major iron and coal mines, oil fields and power plants (Thermal and Nuclear), <u>Major sea ports and International airports</u> of India.
