## St. Cecilia's Public School A Workshop on Swami Vivekanand

A workshop was conducted by Madam Meena, the Primary Co-ordinator, for the students of class VI-VIII on the topic – 'Swami Vivekanand', on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

Swami's teachings not only motivated the youth but also the whole world. He laid the true foundations of India's unity as a nation. He taught how to live together with so much of diversities.

He played a key role in isolating India's culture from the rest of the world. It was a very useful workshop for the students. A question-answer round was also introduced by Madam Meena in which the students were asked interesting questions on the life of the saint.
