Workshop by Honourable Dr Charvi Kalra on 'Medical Emergencies – Do's and Don'ts' Basic First Aid for Medical Emergencies

The speaker cloased the session by emphasizing that when a serious injury occurs, one has to think and act quickly. Medical assistance may be only minutes away, but sometimes seconds count.
