YOUTH PARLIAMENT REPORT

The Democracy Club of St. Cecilia's Public School conducted Youth parliament on Friday, February 6th, 2026 in the school premises to discuss the pressing issue of 'vote chori', a form of electoral fraud. Students from VII, IX & XI participated in the event, depicting the portfolios of various parliamentarians assigned to them, showcasing their knowledge, critical thinking & public speaking skills.

The Youth parliament commenced with the entry of the speaker of the House. The motion "This House believes that vote chori is a significant threat to democracy" was introduced. The home minister stated that the government is taking adequate measures to prevent vote chori. He emphasized the importance of focusing on economic growth & development. The finance minister argued that the opposition is exaggerating the issue of vote chori to gain political mileage. She claimed that the government's electoral reforms are sufficient to address the problem.

Whereas, the leader of the opposition countered that vote chori is a widespread issue and demanded stricter laws & greater transparency in the electoral process. Opposition accused the government of being complicit in vote chori, citing alleged instances of corruption, and urged the government to take immediate action to address the issue.

This Youth Parliament provided a valuable platform for students to engage with the democratic process, demonstrating a keen understanding of the issue and a passion for creating positive change. Madam Principal appreciated the participants for their confidence, passion and well presentation.
